<u>Pupil Premium Funding</u> As a school, we receive an amount of funding called 'pupil premium' from the Government which is dependent on whether families are in receipt of certain benefits.

It is important for our school funding that if you are in receipt of any of the following benefits that you speak to Mrs Julie Chesters at the school office. This funding, if you are eligible, will directly benefit your own child.

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support;
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance;
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance;
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999
- Guaranteed element of Pension Credit;
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
