## **After School Clubs**

To book onto an after school club please book via school money for the half term. All clubs will be at a cost of £1.50 a week and must be paid for prior to them attending. We have worked hard over the years to keep clubs free but due to budget cuts, this is no longer possible. The school will not be making any profit from the clubs, money taken will go towards staffing costs and resources which are needed to enable them to run.

**Swimming.** Long Mynd, Stiperstones and Lawley will be swimming from next MONDAY, 9<sup>th</sup> September for 5 weeks until 7<sup>th</sup> October. The first session children will be leaving school after an early lunch at 12.00pm and will be returning to school for 2.00pm. The second session will be leaving school at 12.45 and will be returning to school for 3.00pm. Please be aware that there may be a slight delay at the end of the day depending on traffic, as we will now be using The Flash swimming pool in Welshpool.
