Water Bottles

All children are required to bring a water bottle into school each day. All water fountains have been turned off and because all children will be eating in their classrooms we are unable to provide a drink at lunchtime. For drinks throughout the day the bottle must be filled with **water** only. You are able to bring an additional drink of squash for lunchtime if you wish.

Free School Meals

Parents/carers can make an application online through the Shropshire Council website <u>https://shropshire.gov.uk/free-school-meals/apply-for-free-school-meals/</u>. When a parent/carer applies online the system will be able to confirm eligibility at point of application.

It is important for our school funding that if you are in receipt of certain benefits that you apply online, even if your child is already receiving free school meals through the universal free school meal system (Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 children) This funding, if you are eligible, will directly benefit your own child.

Parking

The village hall car park is open for parking when picking up and dropping off. Please can I remind all parents that the staff car park must not be used at any time.

Coronavirus

If your child becomes unwell with symptoms your child together with their siblings & the rest of your household must stay at home. You will then all need to be tested. Please inform school of the reason for absence and also the test result when known.

Earrings

During PE all jewellery must be removed this includes earrings. We ask that if your child is unable to remove their earrings for school on a PE day that they put tape over their ears to protect them. We are unable to help the children put tape on and they will need to be able to do this independently.
