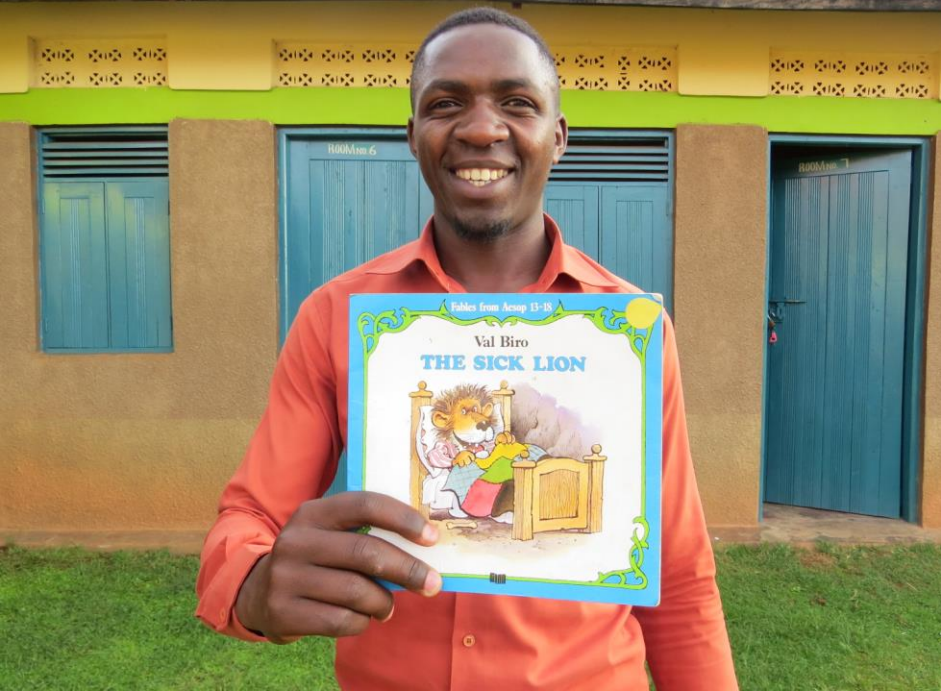
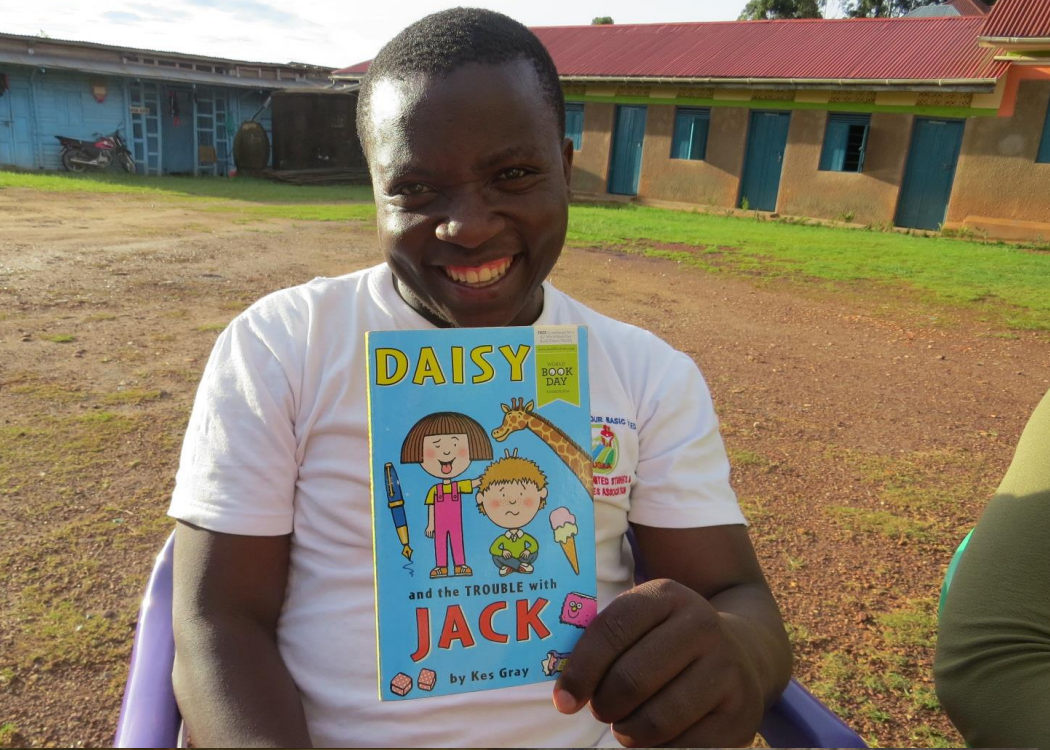




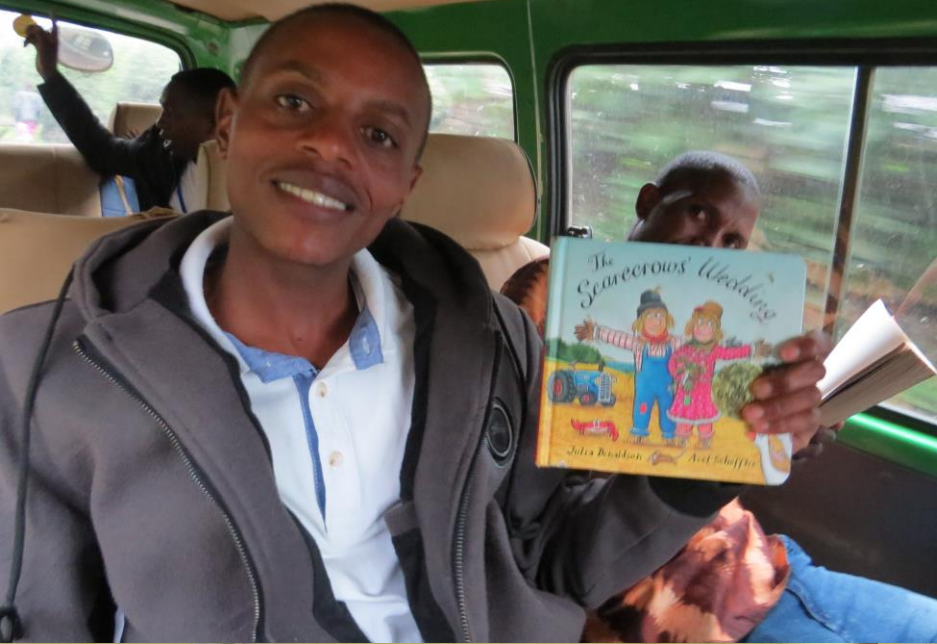
What we really want to do

the Ugandan children.

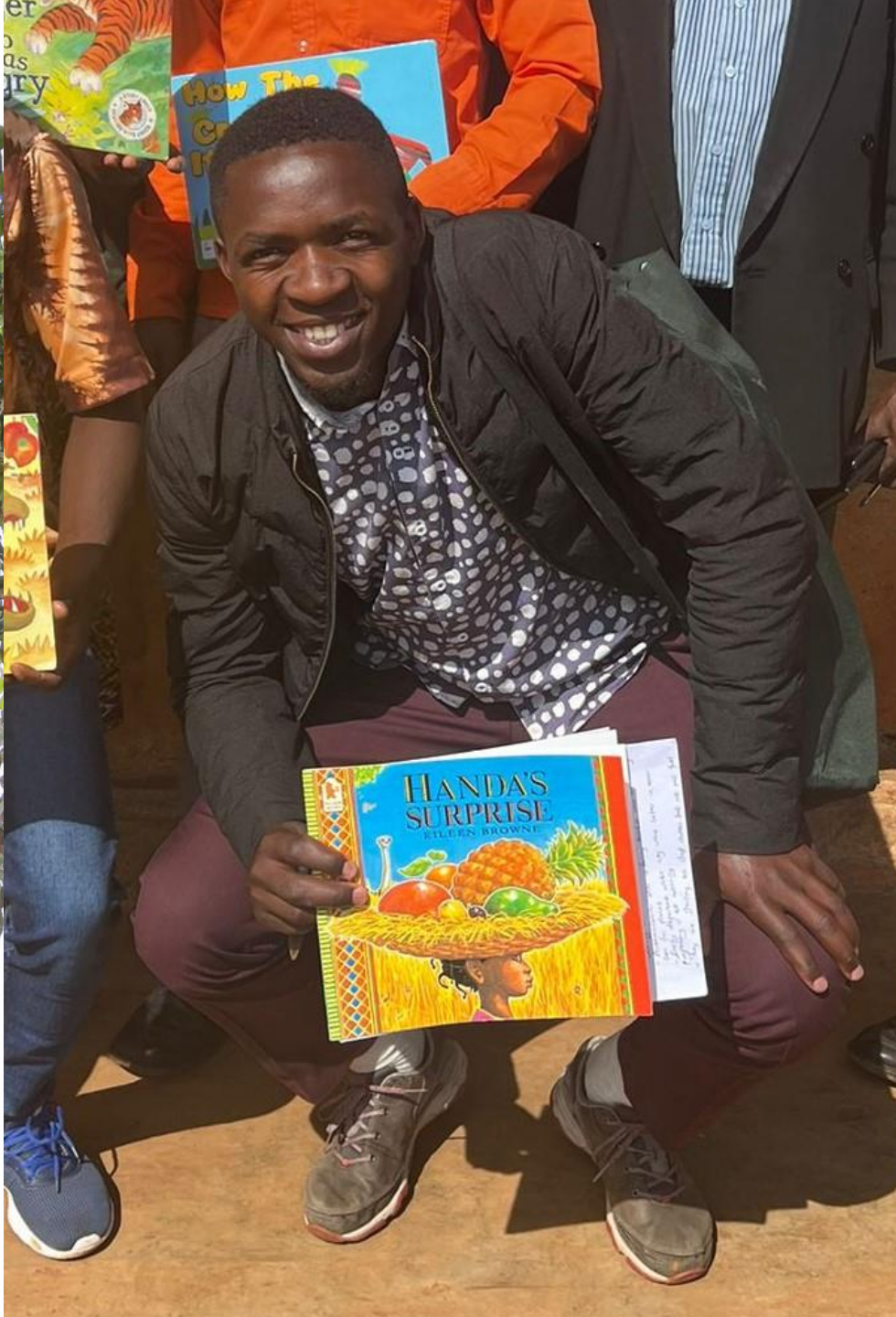







